SUPER MONEY TERMS

A **NEED** IS SOMETHING THAT IS NECESSARY TO LIVE. FOR EXAMPLE, A HOME, FOOD AND CLOTHING ARE NEEDS.

A **WANT** IS SOMETHING THAT IS NOT NECESSARY TO LIVE BUT YOU DESIRE OR WISH FOR IT. FOR EXAMPLE, A NEW BIKE, VIDEO GAME, AND VACATIONS ARE ALL WANTS.

A **BUDGET** IS A PLAN FOR SPENDING AND SAVING YOUR MONEY.

A **SAVINGS ACCOUNT** IS A BANK ACCOUNT WHERE YOU KEEP THE MONEY YOU SAVE AND STORE FOR FUTURE USE.

INTEREST IS THE MONEY YOU EARN FROM YOUR SAVINGS ACCOUNT.

A **CHECKING ACCOUNT** IS A BANK ACCOUNT DESIGNED FOR SPENDING YOUR MONEY.

A **DEBIT CARD** IS A CARD THAT ALLOWS YOU TO MAKE PURCHASES WITH MONEY FROM YOUR CHECKING ACCOUNT.

A **CREDIT CARD** IS A CARD FOR MAKING PURCHASES WITH MONEY THAT YOU BORROW AND PAY BACK LATER.

A **PREPAID CARD** IS A PAYMENT CARD THAT YOU PRE-LOAD WITH YOUR OWN MONEY, SUCH AS A GIFT CARD OR GAME CARD.

AN **EMERGENCY FUND** IS MONEY YOU SAVE TO USE IF SOMETHING UNEXPECTED HAPPENS.

A **DEPOSIT** IS WHEN MONEY IS PUT INTO YOUR BANK ACCOUNT.

A **WITHDRAWAL** IS TO TAKE MONEY OUT OF YOUR BANK ACCOUNT.

A **LOAN** IS MONEY BORROWED FROM A BANK.

A **COST** IS THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THAT HAS TO BE SPENT TO BUY A GOOD OR SERVICE.

DEBIT OR CREDIT?

DEBIT

- PAYING WITH DEBIT IS LIKE SPENDING CASH
- YOU CAN ONLY SPEND THE AMOUNT THAT IS IN YOUR ACCOUNT

CREDIT

- PAYING WITH CREDIT IS LIKE BORROWING MONEY
- YOU HAVE THE OPTION TO PAY OFF YOUR BALANCE OVER TIME WITH INTEREST.
- YOU CAN SPEND UP TO YOUR CREDIT LIMIT
